Fundraising is underway for the Class of 2026 Project Graduation and your support is crucial! We appreciate your help as we prepare to host a magical send-off for our high school graduates.

Thursday, June 18, 2026**

Clap-out on Main Street kicks off Project Graduation! Immediately following the graduation ceremony, graduates board buses and travel down Main Street, where community members gather to wish them well.

Buses transport our graduates to 3 secret locations throughout the night! Graduates enjoy a night of good friends, food, games, dancing, and plenty of fun! They will return to MHS about 5:00 am.

Project Graduation is a community-sponsored event designed to keep our high school graduates and the community safe. It is an all-night **drug and alcohol-free** celebration, and our goal is to have 100% of our graduates attend!

The cost of Project Graduation is approximately \$300 per graduate and is a guideline for a suggested TAX deductible donation. Project Graduation is entirely funded by the generous donations from our senior families, corporate partners and the Moorestown community at large.

This year, in recognition of all the other monetary “asks” of our senior parents, we are partnering with SnapRaise to help achieve our fundraising goals. SnapRaise is an online fundraising platform for teams, clubs, and activity groups that is already in use by many other Moorestown groups. Participation in the Snap Raise fundraiser for Project Graduation is completely voluntary and designed to present an alternate way for families to support Project Graduation without feeling the entire burden of the per graduate cost. We are suggesting families consider signing up for a SnapRaise account to help collect donations over a four-week period (late January to the end of February). For families who choose to participate, the student sets up an account on the Snap Raise platform and provides email addresses of family and friends. That’s it! SnapRaise handles the rest! They will take care of sending the emails. Families are encouraged to post about the fundraiser on social media. Any student who already has a SnapRaise account from another team or club will not have to set up a new account and is able to use their existing contacts.
